GRANT PROGRAMS

The New Haven Schools Foundation offers grants each year in the following areas, as our budget allows. The application period generally opens in February, and awards are given by the end of the school year for use the following year.

INNOVATIONS IN EDUCATION - Classroom Grants

This program puts money directly into the classroom for special activities that enhance learning activities. Teachers may apply for a grant to cover things like supplies, equipment, or field trip expenses.

PROJECT: ENRICHMENT - Program Grants

Teachers, coaches, advisors and others may apply for a grant to provide funds for their co-curricular or extracurricular activities for New Haven students. Music, the arts, sports, forensics and many other programs eligible.

STEM GRANTS – Program or Classroom Grants

Grants provided through this program are focused in the areas of science, technology, engineering, and math. They can be used for materials, supplies, or even parts to build robots.

VIRGINIA SWIHART MEMORIAL FUND - New Teacher Grants

Established in memory of a long time District principal and administrator. This fund helps support beginning teachers by providing small stipends for classroom activities.

BRIAN KELLY MEMORIAL TUTORING / LITERACY FUND - Program Grants

This program was named in memory of a Logan student who passed away at a young age. Teachers or administrators may request a grant to offset the cost of tutorings program helping New Haven students.
